### 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

- Curriculum committee will develop a vision for the district in future course offerings for student's college and career readiness.

- Community service requirements will be in place for all students grades nine through twelve and will be part of their graduation requirement.
- Implement a credit recovery program (CBI) into the district that will challenge students and allow them the opportunity to achieve academic success towards graduation.

### 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

- The curriculum committee will evaluate current data, and the changes implemented over the past two years to ensure the district moves forward.
- Graduation requirements will continuously be updated to meet the needs of all students. Graduation seals will be expanded and career tech opportunities will be explored.
